Character Breakdown

Matilda Wormwood- The hero of the show. She's brilliant, resilient, creative, and kind, despite growing up in difficult circumstances. Her parents treat her poorly, but Matilda escapes into a world of books, which puts her reading level far above the other children in her class, and she develops a bit of magical power in an effort to defeat Trunchbull.

Eric- An expressive student at school with Matilda.

Amanda- A pigtailed student at school with Matilda.

Bruce- One of Matilda's schoolmates. He has the bad luck to get caught after eating Trunchbull's cake. Bruce goes through quite a transformation throughout the show.

Hortensia, Alice, Tommy- Alice, Hortensia, and Tommy are classmates of Matilda.

Lavender- One of the kids at school with Matilda. She is kind and bright (though not as brilliant as Matilda) and quickly decides that Matilda is her best friend.

Nigel- One of the kids at school with Matilda. He is enthusiastic, sweet, and always in a bit of a panic.

Mr. Wormwood- Matilda's father. He is egotistical, rude, and not very bright, not to mention a liar. Though Mr. Wormwood is not a good person and he is mean to Matilda, his harebrained schemes can be hilariously funny.

Mrs. Wormwood- Matilda's mother. Like her husband, she dislikes Matilda and does not understand why her daughter loves to read. Mrs. Wormwood is selfish, obsessed with her own appearance, and believes everything she sees on TV. Her dancing lessons with Rudolpho are the most important part of her day.

Michael- Matilda's brother. He is not very bright, though he is the apple of his father's eye.

Mrs. Phelps- The kindly librarian who loves hearing Matilda's stories.

Escapologist- A character of Matilda's creation. Everything this character does is grand and exaggerated.

Acrobat- A product of Matilda's imagination.

Miss Honey- A teacher at Matilda's school. She is kind, is generous, and really cares about the children despite her own desperate circumstances.

Agatha Trunchbull- The quintessential terrifying tyrant. As headmistress, she runs her school like a dictator, making up arbitrary rules to suit her every whim and dreaming up creative punishments.

Rudolpho- Mrs. Wormwood's self-obsessed dance teacher.

Sergei- A customer swindled by Mr. Wormwood. Though he shows up looking for payback, Matilda has had quite enough of revenge, and Sergei lets the Wormwoods escape.

Ensemble- Ensemble roles include Russians, Little Kids, Big Kids (including Big Kid 1, Big Kid 2, and Big Kid 3), Kids, Mums, Dads, the Cook, and the Mechanic.

Bios of Production Team

Director, Kaitlyn Moccia is our Artistic Director for GymStars Junior Theatre Company. Kaitlyn is a passionate performing artist, educator, and creative leader whose lifelong love of theatre has shaped a dynamic career spanning performance, design, writing, and arts education. Born and raised in Stockton, California, Kaitlyn discovered her passion for the stage at an early age, performing in more than 40 children's theatre productions before graduating from Lincoln High School. She went on to earn her Bachelor of Fine Arts in Theatre from Texas State University, graduating summa cum laude with emphases in Acting, Playwriting, and Costume Design. During her time at Texas State, Kaitlyn studied Shakespeare at London's historic Globe Theatre, became one of the inaugural members of the university's Performance and Production Advisory Committee, and honed specialized skills in traditional costume sketch rendering and corset construction. Her talent as a playwright also earned recognition when one of her original works was selected as a regional finalist at the Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival. Kaitlyn's professional experience reflects her versatility and commitment to the arts. She has designed and costumed multiple full-length productions for respected organizations including the Broadway Training Center and internationally renowned Stagedoor Manor, where she created imaginative costumes that helped bring young performers' stories to life. Her creative journey has also included studying improvisation at New York City's renowned PIT (People's Improv Theater), working as a motion-capture performer, and teaching visual arts through painting, ceramics, glass fusing, and other creative mediums. Whether she is acting, writing, designing, teaching, or mentoring young artists, Kaitlyn brings enthusiasm, creativity, and a deep belief in the transformative power of the arts. She is thrilled to return to her roots in Stockton and share the joy, confidence, and sense of community that theatre can inspire in people of all ages.

Music Director, Joan Calonico graduated from the University of Pacific Conservatory of Music in 1981 with a bachelor's degree in Music Education. She was a General Music and Choral Specialist in Lincoln Unified School District for 20 years. After earning a master's degree in Educational Administration, Mrs. Calonico became principal of Lincoln Elementary School and later, Don Riggio School, where Visual & Performing Arts are an integral part of every student's education. She has directed the Stockton Youth Chorale since 2002 and making music with kids is her favorite thing to do.

Choreographer, Machele Johnson has over 20 years of dance training and performance experience. She graduated from a high school with a full-time theater and performing arts program and has been teaching all styles of dance at GymStars since 2014. While she enjoys teaching every style, ballet and musical theater are her favorites. In addition to dance, Machele has degrees in Communication Sciences and Disorders and English, bringing an understanding of communication, voice, and performance to her teaching.
