What is competitive club cheerleading?

The answer is simple!

Cypress Cheer Elite is created for athletes ages 9-14 who are interested in trying out and joining the school cheer teams in the Cypress area school district. Since junior high cheerleading is not available in the district, there continues to be no programs designed to prepare athletes who are interested in trying out for their school cheer teams. Though All-Star cheer is available, it doesn't compete in the traditional setting similar to High School like Cypress Cheer Elite. Competitive club cheerleading is specifically created for the purpose of teaching athletes what it is to be a high school cheerleader and how to prepare for it. Our goal is, to create a team that will attend spirit camps and competitions, just as their local High Schools do. These camps are offered and designed for school cheerleaders, to help teach athletes the fundamental skills required for tryouts but in a competitive structure to help build an athlete's competitive mindset and receive the same recognition that the school cheerleaders receive with their teams at summer camps and NCA High School and Jr. High School Nationals!

What kind of commitment does it require?

This team will be practicing twice a week for two and a half hours each practice, with a mandatory tumbling class as well. Being on this team is a full commitment, similar to a High School cheer squad, requiring a minimum of 6-7 hours of training a week. The mandatory tumbling class may be selected from our weekly tumbling schedule based on what works best for the athlete. We also encourage attending Open Gym as well.

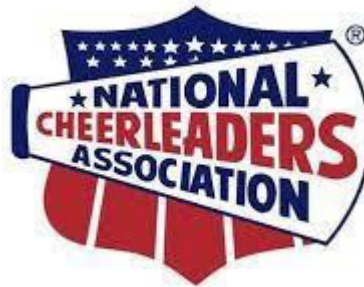

Our finances are broken down into payments with their due dates listed next to the pricing; the initial deposit will go towards uniforms and summer camp which will be due at the parent meeting. **The remaining balance for summer camp, uniforms, practice wear and supplies will be together in 3 different payments of \$305 that will need to be paid off before summer camp those due dates are April 10th, May 10th, and June 10th. All Competition fees, due the 10th of each month beginning in August, must be paid off by December 10th.**

The competitions that this team will be performing at will be selected for their judging background and expertise in scoring, to help build and remodel the routine as needed. Cypress Cheer Elite will only be attending 3 competitions, all of which are required for us to travel to. This includes NCA- which is hosted in Dallas at the Kay Bailey Hutchison convention center. NCA is considered our end of year competition.

Cheer Factory Payment Agreement Options

Cheer Factory 2023-2024 Class Registration Agreement

(initial)_____ I understand that I am registering my athlete_____, for the 2023-2024 Cypress Elite Cheer Club program that runs through January 2024. I also understand that if I decide to withdraw my athlete for any reason before the end of the season I must complete a **WITHDRAWAL FORM THE MONTH PRIOR and understand NO REFUNDS will be issued for tuition/competition fees or items purchased released.** I understand that choosing to "no show" classes does not serve as official withdraw and tuition for the classes will continue to accrue and I will be obligated to pay until a withdraw form is completed. I also understand that calling or emailing the office does not suffice as proper notification. Only a signed withdraw form will officially remove my athlete(s) from the classes they are registered in. **Additionally I understand that a re-choreography fee of \$350 will be assessed to my account and charged if my athlete chooses to quit the team for any reason during the season.**

(initial)_____ I acknowledge that all tuition will be drafted on the 25th of the month prior and will be considered **LATE** if not paid by the 1st of each month. If my account is not paid by the 1st I understand that a \$25.00 late fee will be assessed and all outstanding fees not paid by the 5th of each month will be automatically charged, with late fee, to my debit/credit card on file. If the credit card on file is declined, I understand the student will be withheld from participating in any classes/practices/competitions until our account is cleared up. I also understand Cheer Factory has a NO REFUND policy which also includes All Star and Club cheer. If my tumbling athlete decides to quit mid-session for any reason and does not submit the required 30 Day notice, they will still be responsible for tuition until the withdraw form is completed and submitted to the front desk. If my athlete is an All Star athlete I am aware that this is a 12 month commitment and refunds will not be issued for any reason if my athlete decides to quit before the season ends. Additionally, I understand a \$350 re-choreography fee will be charged for any All Star athlete that quits mid-season to help cover the additional time of staff to fix the sections of the routine my athlete was in.

(initial)_____ I understand that in the event my athlete will miss class for any reason, I need to call the gym office no later than the class start time to let Cheer Factory know of my student's absence. Make-up classes are available. Make-up classes are by reservation and student must be currently enrolled in the program. I also understand that my athlete is limited to 1 makeup pass per month. I understand that if my athlete misses more than 2 classes without notifying the gym office, my athlete may be dropped from their class. I understand tuition is not prorated due to absences or holidays.

Standard Billing Procedures

- NO ATHLETE WILL BE ALLOWED TO REGISTER WITH AN OUTSTANDING BALANCE.
- Accounts with a balance MUST meet with management before signing up for classes. CURRENT CF MEMBERS WITH DELINQUENT ACCOUNT HISTORY WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY AN ADDITIONAL DEPOSIT PER ATHLETE UP FRONT TO REGISTER FOR A CLASS.
- Fees will post to your CF account on the 20th of the month prior to which it's due. A late fee of \$25.00 will be applied if not received by the 1st of each month.
- All unpaid balances will be charged to the card on file on the 5th of each month with late fee, declined charges will result in suspension from classes/practices until paid.
- If you prefer NOT to charge the card on file, you must bring in cash or check by the 1st of the month (or sooner should the gym be closed). Additional grace period will not be given if the 1st falls on a weekend.
- All accounts are required to have a valid credit card on file at all times even if paying by cash or check monthly. It is your responsibility to fill out a new CC authorization form for lost/stolen/expired cards, billing address changes, etc. All applicable fees will be charged if the card on file is declined for ANY REASON.
- For any auto draft account, if payment is returned for any reason you will have 24 hours to clear the account or a \$25.00 late fee will be applied. In the event of any returned payment, any applicable NSF/processing fees will be charged to my account.
- No account will be allowed to have fees roll over from month to month.
- Athletes with a balance will not be allowed to participate in class until ALL fees are paid in full.
- If my athlete plans to drop from any Cheer Factory class, I must submit the required withdrawal notice to the gym office or email to cfstaff@cheerfactorytx.com by the 1st of the month prior to the last month my athlete will attend.

- I understand there must be perfection before progression. I will not attempt to learn advanced tumbling skills before perfecting the basics.
- I will maintain good sportsmanship at all times when representing Cheer Factory. Abusive behavior, lying, and/or any other form of negative behavior are grounds for removal from this program.
- I understand that the parent viewing areas should be a positive place, and I may be prohibited from using the parent viewing area if I cannot maintain a positive attitude or keep comments to myself. Furthermore, I understand that the parent viewing area is not my personal workshop, living room, dining room, party room or day care. I will respect others and use it for the sole purpose of viewing my child. All siblings waiting in the parent room will be supervised and not allowed to run around or be disruptive to others trying to watch their athlete in classes.
